



BUDGET HEARING UPDATE

Below, you will find the most recent information on the joint Governor's Office/Legislative Budget Board hearings on state agencies' budget requests for the 2010-11 biennium. The hearings will take place at the Capitol Complex in Austin, Texas.

- **State officials have instructed agencies to submit baseline budget proposals for 2010-11 without funding for higher energy prices, health care costs, and other inflation. If enacted, these baseline budgets would cut state services.**
- **The budget instructions also require state agencies to explain how they would cut general spending by 10%.**
- **You can speak out on agencies budget proposals in August and September during pre-session joint hearings before the Legislative Budget Board and Governor's Budget Office.**
